

7 Days Kenya Intrepid Safari

This Safari offers the truly intrepid spirit, the opportunity to experience the real untamed bush and Magnificent animals, immersed completely in this glorious wilderness. Start the adventure at Amboseli Game Reserve arguably the best place to watch elephants in East Africa! Bounded by the towering Mt. Kilimanjaro (second highest mountain in the world), Amboseli boasts of over 80 animal species ranging from the minute spectacled elephant shrew to the huge bulk of the African Elephant. Then shuttle to Tsavo, Kenya's largest National Park famed for the mane less- man eating lions and dust red elephants. Tsavo is painted on a sprawling canvas of endless skies, emerald hills; liquid lava flows, and palm fringed rivers. Experience the contrasting scenery, spectacular wildlife and the civilized charms of this great land and lastly wind up this great tour by soaking up in the Indian Ocean in an all inclusive beach resort in Watamu north of Mombasa.

Day 1: Nairobi- Amboseli

We depart from Nairobi for a 5-hour drive to the world's renowned Amboseli National Park, nestled on the foothills of Mt. Kilimanjaro on the southern border of Kenya and Tanzania. Check in at the Amboseli Serena Lodge/Oltukai Lodge. After lunch, time to explore Amboseli's hidden treasures. Expect huge herds of elephants wallowing in the swamp, giraffes, buffaloes, and zebras amongst a host of avifaunal species against the spectacular backdrop of the snow capped roof of Africa; Mt. Kilimanjaro. Overnight Amboseli Serena lodge (L, D)



Day 2: Amboseli

It's a ritual of morning and evening game drives exploring the intrigues and fascinating inhabitants of the Amboseli; Look out for animals protecting their young, attracting mates, or gorging themselves on a recent kill on morning and afternoon game drives. A beautiful swimming pool at the lodge provides a refreshing chance to cool off in the heat of the day. After lunch, we experience a maasai cultural village; learn how these celebrated African tribesmen and women live. Meals and overnight in the lodge. (B, L, D)

Day 3: Amboseli -Tsavo East

Today after breakfast (0800hrs), farewell to Amboseli and drive for 3 hours to Tsavo East National Park checking in at Voi Wildlife lodge just in time for lunch. In 1989, Tsavo was notorious for the man-eating lions but today it is famous for the numerous prides of maneless lions and the dust red elephants that patrol the plains. In the cool hours of the day after lunch, we venture into the pristine wilderness in search of the great beasts and a wide array of colorful birds. Overnight Voi Wildlife Lodge. (B, L, D)

**Day 4: Tsavo East National Park**

Our last full day in Tsavo is a real highlight, we may opt for game drives for further exploration of the expansive Tsavo or relaxing nature walks around the camp. Later in the day at 1700hrs, we visit our adopted baby elephants at the Sheldrick orphanage, proving a memorable opportunity to interact with the baby jumbos as they prepare to go back to the wild. (Visit to the orphanage is limited to foster parents only (To be a foster parent please visit www.sheldrickwildlifetrust.org) Return to Voi Wildlife Lodge for overnight stay. (B, L, D)

Days 5 and 6: Watamu

Wake up to the sights and sounds of the bush before breakfast. We then drive to Watamu at the Kenyan coast (approx. 3 hours) where we will be fully hosted in our beach resort. After all the bush and game, you ought to slow down, shake off the safari dust and just relax. We can opt to engage in motorized and non-motorized water sports; scuba diving, wind surfing, canoeing, snorkeling, tennis or a visit to nearby historical sites. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Watamu- Nairobi

Greet your last day in Watamu with a hearty breakfast followed by any last minute shopping or beach combing. Afternoon transfer to Malindi airport for your 1440 hrs one-hour flight to Nairobi. Final dinner hosted by the Finch Travels safari team before your transfer to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport for your flight back home. (B, L, D)
